



PARENTAL COMMITMENT POLICY

Dollard Synchro is a not-for-profit organization, operated by coaches and volunteer parents and former athlete members through an Executive Board. Participation by members in the Club management is crucial to the success of the club and without their efforts the Club could not operate.

In order to fulfill the Dollard Synchro Parental Commitment all families of competitive athletes are asked to become involved in all club-hosted meets that includes positions in scoring, hospitality, admissions, audio/video, etc. as well as the contribution of food items. **This season Dollard Synchro is hosting the National Imposed Figures Competition on November 2nd and 3rd, 2019, as well as the potential to host Quebec Masters Provincial Championships one weekend in April or May (exact date still to be confirmed). Parents will be required to complete three 2-3 hour shifts per competition during the 2019-2020 season.**

Commitment requirements of National stream families:

- Fulfill approximately three 2-3 hour shifts during each competition weekend. The exact number of shifts will be determined once the competition schedule is received from Synchro Quebec.
- Provide 2-3 food items for judges and volunteers. Exact contribution to be determined once the number of judges/volunteers is confirmed.
- At registration, parents of National Stream athletes must submit a Parental Commitment Policy deposit check, post-dated December 1 or 15, 2018 of \$250. The check will be cashed in December if families have not fulfilled the above responsibilities.

Commitment requirements of Provincial stream families:

- Fulfill ONE shift during each competition weekend.
- Provide 2-3 food items for judges and volunteers. Exact contribution to be determined once the number of judges/volunteers is confirmed.
- At registration parents of Provincial Stream athletes must submit a Parental Commitment Policy deposit check, post-dated December 1 or 15, 2018 of \$100. The check will be cashed in December if families have not fulfilled the above responsibilities.

Information on the exact number of shifts and food items to contribute will be communicated by email in the weeks prior to the competition. It is the responsibility of parents to follow the instructions provided and sign up to fulfill their commitment. All parents of the Club are encouraged to give as much of their time as possible in order to help the competition run smoothly. Siblings of a minimum of age 10 can also volunteer for simpler tasks.

Please note that hosting a competition greatly reduces competition fees. A competition at Dollard will cost the athlete approximately \$100 versus \$500 for the same competition in Quebec City. Without parents' contributions of food for officials and volunteering of their time we would not be able to host a competition, which will directly impact the competition fees.
